TREATMENT PERIOD

1 February - 15 March, 2010

THE PATIENT

A 63 year old female suffered an infected wound site and subsequent wound dehiscence to a post operative hernia scar.

TREATMENT

1 February, 2010 The post operative wound measured 10cm in length and 1 cm in width when management commenced. The selected dressing (Sorbact® Absorption) was changed twice daily by the patient.

5 February, 2010 Frequency of dressing change reduced to daily. Wound exudate decreased and healing noted. No pain reported.

8 March, 2010 Wound continued to heal well. Dressing regimen unchanged.

22 March, 2010 The final wound state was reported as two small ulcers measuring 5x2cm and 2x1cm respectively. Both ulcers demonstrated healthy granulation tissue and continued improvement.
