

# NO 18 SORBACT® CLINICAL CASE

Trauma wound with venous insufficiency on the right lower leg

## WOUND TYPE

Trauma wound on a background of venous insufficiency

## PRODUCT

Sorbact® Compress

## CONTRY/LOCATION

DK - Sorø Municipality

## TREATMENT PERIOD

18 February – 14 April, 2010

## THE PATIENT

An elderly man with a background of venous insufficiency sustained a haematoma post trauma to the right leg.

## THE TREATMENT

**18 February, 2010** Initial treatment created problems secondary to wound adherence. Wound management was then changed to Sorbact® Compress which according to the clinical staff, was easy to use and did not adhere to the wound. A superabsorbant secondary dressing was used to support with a dressing change 3 times per week arranged. Compression stockings applied.

**3 March, 2010** Significant improvement noted. Management continued.

**12 March, 2010** Dressing change reduced to 2 x times per week.

**26 March, 2010** Dressing change frequency now once per week.

**14 April, 2010** The wound is now fully healed.
